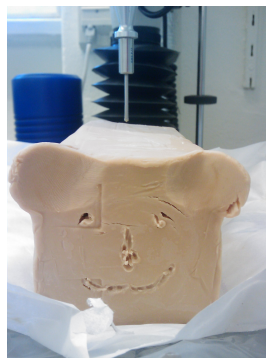
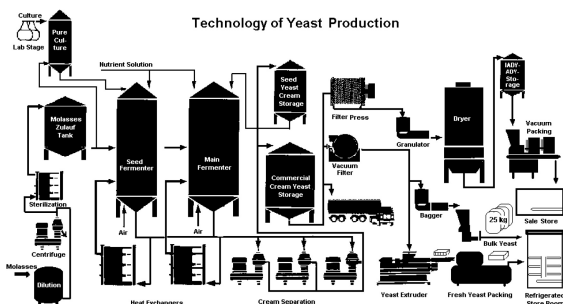


VH Autumn Yeast Technology Seminar 2026
